



Creative potential

Cognitive (foundational capacity of literacy, numeracy and higher order thinking skills), Social, Ethical and Emotional capacity and disposition

Teachers and Faculty as the Heart of the Learning Process


- Promote life skills such as "Communication, Cooperation, Team Work and Resilience".

- Outstanding Research and Continuous Review.



Transforming Curricular & Pedagogical Structure






New pedagogical and curricular structure of school education (5+3+3+4): 3 years in Anganwadi/pre-school and 12 years in school

- Secondary Stage(4) multidisciplinary study, greater critical thinking, flexibility and student choice of subjects
- Middle Stage (3) experiential learning in the sciences, mathematics, arts, social sciences, and humanities
- Preparatory Stage (3) play, discovery, and activity-based and interactive classroom learning
- Foundational stage (5) multilevel, play/activity-based learning

- The key overall thrust of curriculum and pedagogy reform across all the stages will move the education system towards the real understanding and towards "learning how to learn" and away from the culture of rote learning as is largely present today.
- The aim of education will not only be cognitive development but also building character and creating holistic and well- rounded individuals equipped with key 21st century skills.
- All aspects of curriculum and pedagogy will be re-oriented and revamped to attain these critical goals.
- Curriculum frameworks and transaction mechanisms will be developed for ensuring that required skill sets and values are imbibed through engaging processes of teaching learning processes.


